

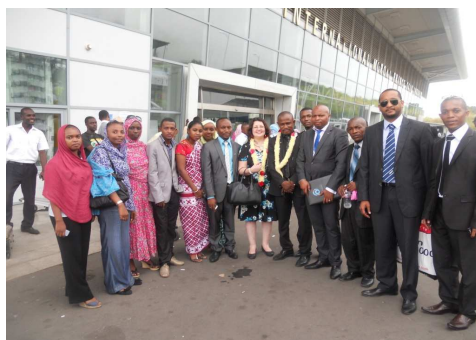


JCI Comoros Official visit

Day 3 : Monday 29th April 2013



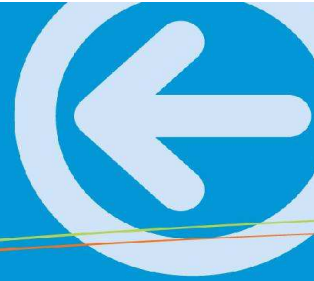
Early in the morning, Vice President Asmaa Benslimane and JCI Comoros National President took the plane to visit Anjouan Island (Comoros 2nd big Island).

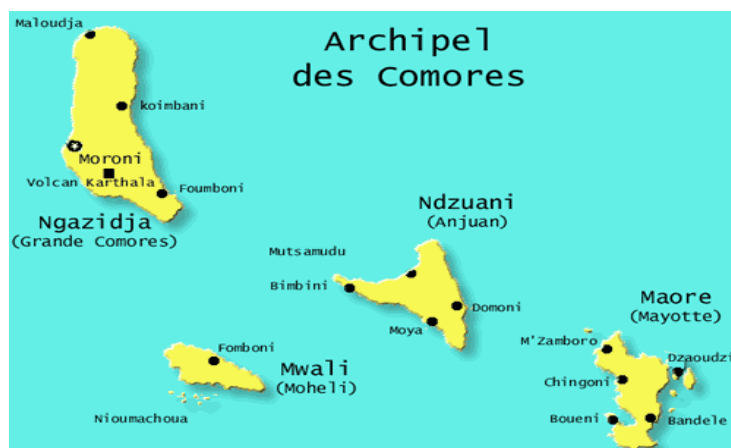
