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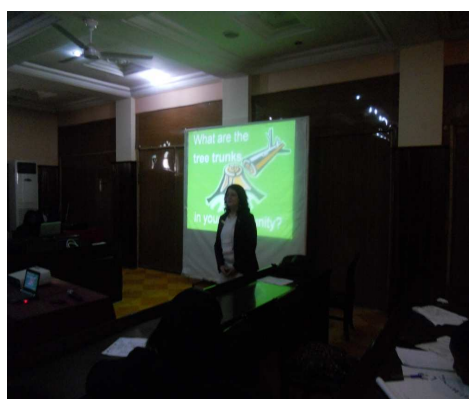


Day 2 : Sunday 14th April 2013

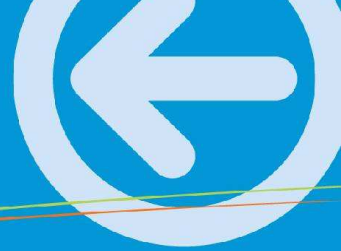


In the afternoon, JCI Impact course was given to 35 officers and members.
