Day 1 : Saturday 23th March 2013







After a warm welcome at Gbesia International Aeroport VIP Lounge (Conakry) by JCI Guinea National Board members and some local officers, the day began with the inauguration of JCI Guinea headquarters with the participation of a crowd of members, national and local board members, Senators and journalists providing an extensive media coverage, the same day, 181 beds was delivered to Donka hospital with the participation of M.
