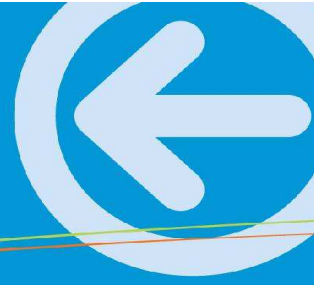
Day 2: Thursday 28th March 2013
